

Leedy "Broadway Parallel"

circa 1937-1945

This beautiful Leedy Broadway Parallel snare drum has a red sparkling pearl finish. This very rare 8" x 14" snare drum has a solid maple shell with maple reinforcing "glue" rings. The interior of the shell is factory painted white. The drum has 16 nickel plated lugs. The third series Broadway Parallel strainer and single flanged "stickchopper" hoops are also nickel plated. The top hoop is stamped "Leedy-Elkhart, Ind. U.S.A." The bottom hoop is stamped "BROADWAY PARALLEL". The badge is a Leedy "Elkhart, Ind. U.S.A.", black and brass badge. The adjustable snares are original. This very beautiful drum belongs to Michael Gilbert of Ft. Lauderdale, Florida.
